



Week 5

Materials

Knitcraft Cotton Blend (50% Cotton, 50% Acrylic; 100g/215m) in:

Yarn A (YA): White x 9 balls

Yarn B (YB): Yellow x 1 ball

Yarn C (YC): Bright Blue x 1 ball

Yarn D (YD): Hot Pink x 2 ball

Yarn E (YE): Lilac x 1 ball

Yarn F (YF): Teal x 2 ball

Yarn G (YG): Mustard x 2 ball

Yarn H (YH): Light Blue x 2 ball

5mm hook

Stitch markers

Tapestry crochet writing - 'hello spring'

Note:

Rows 131-161 are tapestry crochet rows. As such the non-active yarn colour is carried within the stitches when not being used to work the current stitch, while stitches are worked over the top of it. It is not necessary to carry YF to the end of each row.

When the last st of the row has been worked with YF this can be left on the WS of the work to be picked up again in the following row. Colour changes are made with the last yrh of the prev st.

Row 130 (WS):

With YA, 1ch, dc in each st to end, turn.

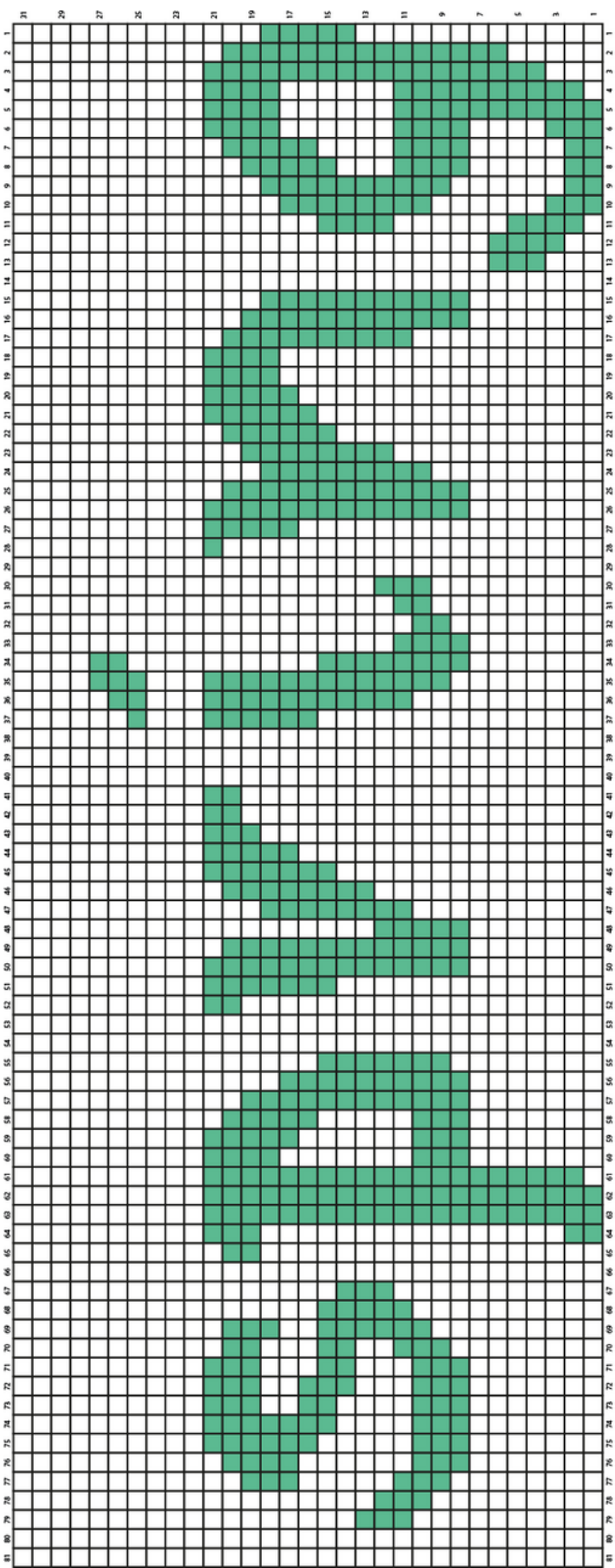
Rows 131-161 of the pattern are worked by following the Tapestry Crochet Hello Spring Chart as follows:

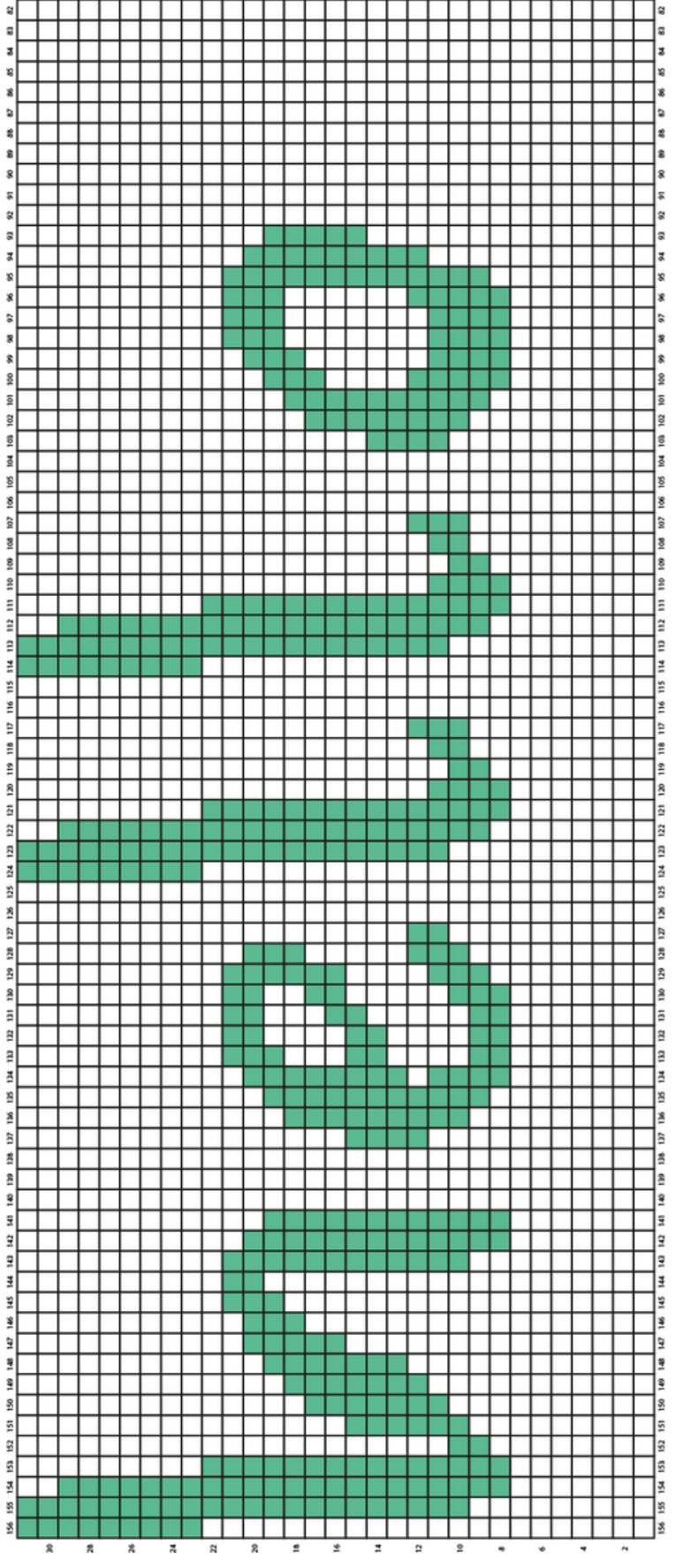
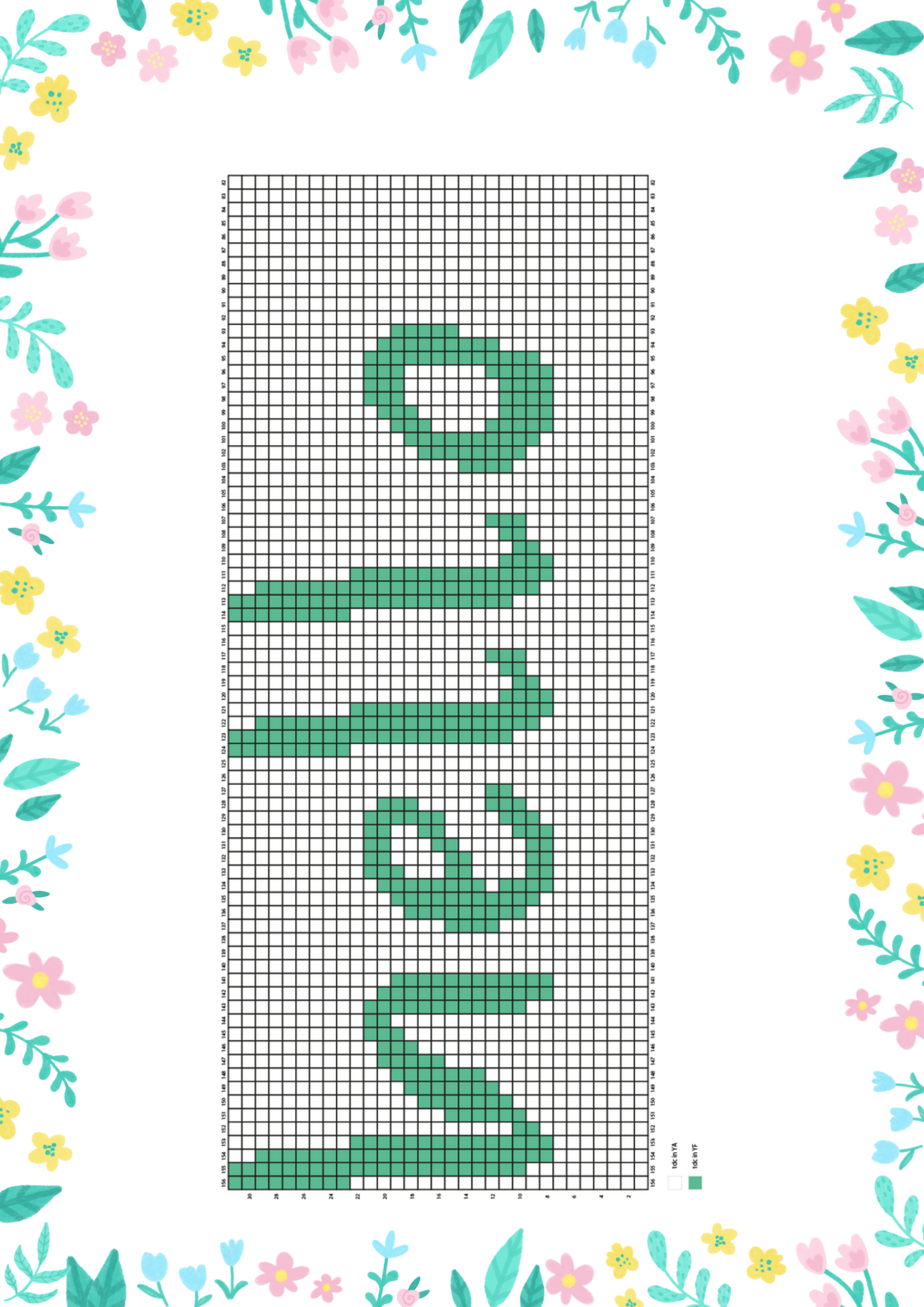
Row 131 (RS):

Ch1, 12dc, in YA, work Row 1 of the chart, work 12dc in YA, turn.

For Rows 132-161:

Continue to follow Rows 2-31 of the chart, begin each row with 1ch, work 12dc in YA, work the appropriate row of the chart, work 12dc in YA, turn. 180 sts, Fasten off YF after Row 160.

Bobble stitch

Row 162:

With YA, 1ch, dc in each st to end, turn.

Rows 163 - 165:

1ch, htr in each st to end, turn. Fasten off YA

Row 166:

With YH, 1ch, *9dc, 1bobble; rep from * to last 10 sts, 10dc, turn. Fasten off YH.

Rows 167 and 168:

With YA, htr in each st to end, turn. Fasten off YA.

Rows 169 - 170:

With YH, 1ch, htr in each st to end, turn. 180 sts.

Bobble stitch clouds

Preparation:

Each cloud is worked separately. As such, prepare six 12gram (24m) yarn balls of YA. Place pegs or clips around the yarn balls to prevent tangling as you work.

YH is carried within sts as sts are work over the top.

Each individual YA yarn ball should be released to the WS of the work when the last st has been made for that cloud in each row.

Colour changes are made with the last yrh of the prev st.

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Rows 171-182 of the pattern are worked by following the Bobble Stitch Cloud Chart as follows:

Row 171 (RS):

With YH, 1ch, 3dc, work Row 1 of chart; 6 times, 3dc in YH, turn

Row 172:

With YH, 1ch, 3dc, work Row 2 of chart; 6 times, 3dc in YH, turn.

For Rows 173-182 continue to follow Rows 3-12 of the chart, begin each row with 1ch, work 3dc in YH, work the appropriate row of the chart; 6 times, work 3dc in YH, turn.

Fasten off all YA yarn balls after Row 182.

Rows 183-186:

With YH, 1ch, dc in each st to end, turn. 180 sts.
