Celia's used to coming up smelling of roses – she's a florist by day, putting a smile on her customers' faces as she helps them celebrate their special occasions. She loves arranging beautiful, seasonal displays for the shop window and spring can only mean one thing: it's tulip time! After work, Celia's dashing off to her craft club (which is really just an excuse for chatting the night away with her creative pals). Tonight, she's showing off her new granny square pom pom bag and finishing off the amigurumi pretzel she started last week.

Materials

Hayfield Bonus DK in Chocolate WI Premium Acrylic in School Green WI Premium Acrylic in Honey Knitcraft Everyday DK in Barbie Pink Knitcraft Everyday DK in Black Hayfield Bonus DK in Purple WI Premium Acrylic in Cream Knitcraft Everyday DK in Pistachio WI Premium Acrylic in Denim Knitcraft Everyday DK in Hot Pink DMC Mouline White Gold Light Effects Embroidery thread 3mm crochet hook Needle Scissors Stitch Marker Safety Eyes Toy Filling Dressmaker pin Ruler

Abbreviations (UK terms)

Dc – double crochet Htr – half treble crochet St(s) – stitch(es) Tr – treble crochet Ch- chains Ss- slip stitch Dc2tog – double crochet 2 stitches together R – rounds/rows

Making the doll

Body Leg 1

Using Chocolate, make a magic ring R1: 6dc into the ring (6) R2: (1dc, 2dc in next st) 3 times (9) R3: (2dc, 2dc in next st) 3 times (12) R4-R11: Dc in every st (12) Change to Honey R12-R13: 1dc in each st (12) Fasten off, leaving a 15cm tail

Leg 2

Work as for Leg 1 but do not fasten off.

R14: Still on Leg 2, ch 5, turn, htr in the 2nd ch from the hook, htr into the next 3 chs, ss into next st on leg 2, missing a st, 10dc around the same leg.

Now 4dc into the tops of the 4 htr link you have just created, then join Leg 1 by working 10dc around it, then 4dc back across the other side of the 4htr link (28)

Using the tail close the gaps at both sides of crotch. R15-R16: 1dc in each st (28) Start stuffing the legs at this point R17-R18: 1dc in each st (28) R19: Change back to Chocolate, 1dc in each st (28) R20-R21: Change to School Green, 1dc in each st (28) R22: (5dc, dc2tog) 4 times (24) R23-24: 1dc in each st (24) R25: (4dc, dc2tog) 4 times (20) R26: 1dc in each st (20) R27: (3dc, dc2tog) 4 times (16)

Start stuffing the body at this point R28: 1dc in each st (16) R29: (2dc, dc2tog) 4 times (12) R30: (2dc, dc2tog) 3 times (9) R31: Change to Chocolate, 1dc in each st (9) R32: (2dc, 2dc in next st) 3 times (12) R33: (2dc, 2dc in next st) 4 times (16) R34: (3dc, 2dc in next st) 4 times (20) R35: (4dc, 2dc in next st) 4 times (24) R36-R40: 1dc in each st Insert safety eyes between rows 37 and 38, 5 sts apart. R41: (4dc, dc2tog) 4 times (20) Sew a small st beside each eye for the eyelashes in black Stitch mouth on row 35, 4 sts apart in Barbie Pink R42: (2dc, dc2tog) 5 times (15) Stuff the neck and head firmly R43: (1dc, dc2tog) 5 times (10) R44: (Dc2tog) 5 times (5) Fasten off and weave in ends.

Arms (make 2)

Using Chocolate, make a magic ring R1: 6dc into the ring (6) R2: (1dc, 2dc in next st) 3 times (9) R3-R5: 1dc in each st (9) Change to School Green R6-R13: 1dc in each st (9) Fasten off leaving a 30cm tail for sewing in.

Stuff the arms so the hands are full, gradually decreasing in volume until you get to the shoulders. Attach to each side of the body around

row 29, weave in ends once secured

Hair

Try to keep the tension a bit looser for this part. Using black yarn make a magic ring R1: 5dc into the ring (5) R2: 2dc into each st (10) R3: (1dc, 2dc in next st) 5 times (15) R4: (2dc, 2dc in next st) 5 times (20) R5: (4dc, 2dc in next st) 4 times (24) R6-R8: 1dc in each st (24) R9: 1dc in the first 14 sts, ch 4, 2htr in 2nd ch from the hook and then 2htr in the next 2 chs, ss into the 15th st, chain 4 again, 2htr in 2nd ch from hook and then 2htr in the next 2 chs, ss into the 16th st. 1dc in the last 8 sts R10: 1dc in the first 10 sts, fasten off keeping a 30cm tail and leaving the remaining 14 sts untouched (this creates slightly more hair at the nape of her neck)

To assemble, place hair on the head, this should fit quite snuggly and only needs a couple of sts to keep in place. Try not to do too many as this sometimes distorts the shape of the head.

Bun

Using black yarn make a magic ring R1: 6dc into the ring (6) R2: 2dc into each st (12) R3: (2dc, 2dc in next st) 4 times (16) R4-R5: 1dc in each st (16) R6: (2dc, dc2tog) 4 times (12) Fasten off leaving a 30cm tail Stuff the bun and sew it onto the top of the hair, stitch onto the head making sure it's fully secured.
