### Abbreviations (UK terms)

BLO – back loop only  
Bpdc – back post double crochet  
Bpstr – back post half treble  
Bptr – back post treble  
Ch – chain  
Ch-1-sp – chain 1 space  
Dc – double crochet  
Htr – half treble  
Mr – magic ring  
SS – slip Stitch  
Tr – Treble  
6trtog – 6 treble together

### What you will need:

- Knitcraft Cotton Blend in Lilac, Mustard, Purple, Teal and White
- 5mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors

### Pattern Notes

The square is worked in the round.  
For the first stitch on each row: Chain 1 to move up to the next round if the round starts with double crochet. Chain 2 if the round starts with a half treble crochet, and chain 3 if the round starts with a treble crochet. These chains do not count as sts. Slip stitch to the first st at the end of each round.



## Main square

### The Filling

Using Lilac, ch 4, join with sl st to form a ring, or work MR.

Set up Rnd: Ch 1 (does not count as stitch), 6 dc in ring, sl st to beg of rnd. (6 dc)

Rnd 1: Ch1, (2dc in next st). 6 times, sl st to beg of rnd. (12)

Rnd 2: Ch1, (1dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times, sl st to beg of rnd. (18)

Rnd 3: Ch1, (2dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times, sl st to beg of rnd. (24)

Rnd 4: Ch1, (3dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times, sl st to beg of rnd. (30)

Rnd 5: Ch1, (2dc, 2dc in next st, 2dc) 6 times, sl st to beg of rnd. (36)

Rnd 6: Ch1, (5dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times, sl st to beg of rnd. (42)

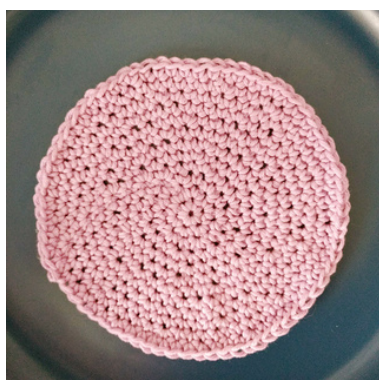
Rnd 7: Ch1, (3dc, 2dc in next st, 3dc) 6 times, sl st to beg of rnd. (48)

Rnd 8: Ch1, (7dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times, sl st to beg of rnd. (54)

Rnd 9: Ch1, (4dc, 2dc in next st, 4dc) 6 times, sl st to beg of rnd. (60)

Rnd 10: Ch1, (9dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times, sl st to beg of rnd. (66)

Rnd 11: Ch1, (5dc, 2dc in next st, 5dc) 6 times, sl st to beg of rnd. Fasten off. (72)

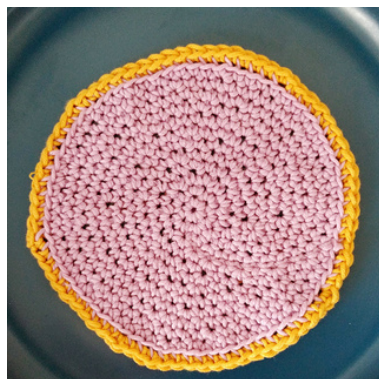




### The Crust

Use Mustard and work BLO

Rnd 12: Ch1, (10dc, 2dc in next st, 7dc) 4 times, sl st to beg of rnd. Fasten off. (76)



### The Plate

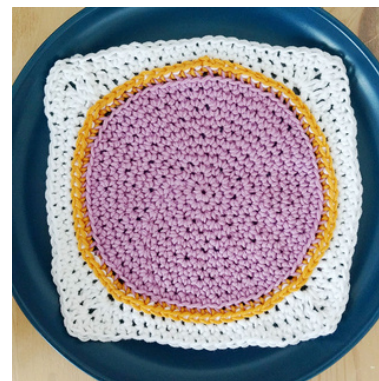
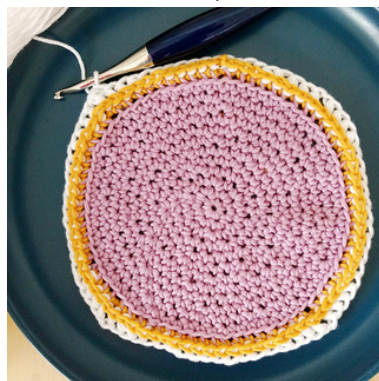
Use White

Rnd 13: Ch2, (Bphttr, ch 1, 4bphttr, 11 bpdc, 3bphttr) 4 times, sl st to beg of rnd. (76 and 4 ch-1-sp)

(If you struggle to make the back post stitches on this round, you can also use the normal stitches. In this way you will get a coloured crust, but it will not be raised.)

Rnd 14: Ss to ch-1-sp, ch3, ([tr, ch 1, tr] in ch-1-sp, 4 htr, 11dc, 4 htr) 4 times, sl st to beg of rnd. (84 and 4 ch-1-sp)

Rnd 15: Ss to ch-1-sp, ch2, ([htr, ch 1, htr] in ch-1-sp, 4 htr, 13dc, 4 htr) 4 times, sl st to beg of rnd. Fasten off. (92 and 4 ch-1-sp)



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### Border

Use Purple, join in any ch1 sp.

Rnd 16: Ch1, ([dc, ch 1, dc] into ch-1-sp, 23 dc) 4 times, sl st to beg of rnd. Fasten off. (100 and 4 ch-1-sp).



### Cream Puffs - make 7

Using white, ch 4, join with sl st to form a ring, or work MR.

Set up Rnd: Ch1 (does not count as stitch), 6 dc in ring, sl st to beg of rnd. (6 dc)

Rnd 1: Ch3, (6tr) into each stitch, sl st to beg of rnd. Fasten off leaving long ends for sewing in place (36).



### Blueberries - make 7

Using Purple, ch 4, join with sl st to form a ring, or work Mr.

Set up Rnd: Ch1 (does not count as stitch), 6 dc in ring, sl st to beg of rnd. (6 dc)

Rnd 1: 6trtog. Fasten off leaving long ends for sewing in place.





### Mint Leaves - make 4

Use Teal

Foundation: ch 6

Rnd 1: dc into second ch from hook, htr, (3tr in next st), htr, dc, ch 1 and now work down the other side of the chain, dc, htr, (3tr in next st), htr, dc. Fasten off leaving long ends for sewing in place



### Assembly

Use the photos for a guide to sew the cream, berries and leaves in place. Make sure that you attach the cream before the berries.
