### Bag

#### Front & Back Granny Squares (Make 2)

Using Cream make a magic ring

R1: Ch2, 9tr into the ring, pull the magic ring closed, ss into the top of the 2 chs and fasten off (10)

R2: Join Barbie Pink between any of the trebles, ch2, 1htr into the same gap, 2htr into each of the next gaps between the cream treble crochets. Ss into the first ch 2 st and fasten off (20)

R3: Join Hot Pink in any gap. Ch2, 1htr in the same gap, ch1 and 2htr in the same gap again to create a corner.

4dc in the next 4 gaps, \*(2htr, ch1, 2htr) into the next st to create another corner, 4dc in the next 4 gaps. Repeat pattern from \* another two times.

Ss into the first ch 2 st and fasten off .

Weave in all of the ends

### Strap

Using Hot Pink ch51, turn, starting in the 2nd ch from the hook, htr in the next 50 chs. Fasten off leaving a long tail.

To assemble the bag, use Hot Pink to attach the strap to three sides of one of the granny squares

Turn over and attach the second granny square in the same way

Join the ends of the strap together with a couple of sts and weave in the ends

### Pompom

Make a small Cream pompom.

Without a pompom maker you can use a ruler.

Cut a length of wool and lay along the ruler

Wrap wool around the ruler


Using the middle length, tie tightly

Shimmy the wool off the ruler carefully and cut the loops in half

Trim so that the pompom is around 2cm.

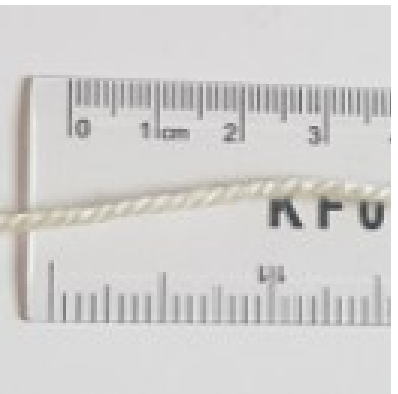
Using a needle, tease the strands apart to give a fluffier pompom

Sew the pompom onto the bag handle





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## **Pretzel**

Using Honey ch31, turn, 1dc in second ch, 1dc in 29 remaining chs. Fasten off leaving a 30cm tail

Cross the ends over and st in place.

Twist the ends and st in place

Fold the loop behind the crossed ends and st in place
