Meet Jojo, a happy kid with a secret alter-ego! In the daytime, he enjoys hanging out with his friends at school and introducing everyone to his bunny sidekick.

You might also notice that he's never without his trusty favourite bag around his neck. That little bag holds a big secret. It's where Jojo keeps his superhero outfit! Whenever he spots any trouble, he's ready to put on his cape and mask before making a dramatic rescue.

Materials

- · Yarn Ricorumi DK x 1 ball for each colour
- o Body: Pastel Pink (007) & Powder (022)
- o Top: Sand (071) & Cream (002)
- o Pants: Mouse Grey (059)
- o Shorts: Clay (066)
- o Hair: Agua (074)
- o Superkid outfit: Sky Blue (031)
- o Bag: Wood (073)
- · A 2.50 mm hook
- · Yarn needle
- Stitch marker
- Toy stuffing
- Sewing pins
- A pair of sharp Scissors
- · Black thread/ lace yarn for eyes and

nose

· Pink makeup to blush the cheeks

Abbreviations (UK terms)

Ch - chain

FLO - Front loop only

BLO - Back loop only

R - Round/ Row

St(s) – stitch(es)

Ss – Slip stitch

Dc - double crochet

Htr - Half treble crochet

Tr - Treble crochet

Inv Dec: Invisible Decrease

Pattern Notes

Use Cross stitch to crochet (X-stitch/ Yarn under) throughout this pattern. Work in a continuous spiral unless otherwise instructed.

Size:

Depending on tension, the approx size 25cm



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Making the doll

Arms (Make 2)

Start with arms first before making the body. Don't stuff arms.

R1: In Pastel Pink, Work 6dc in a magic ring (6)

R2-3: 6dc

Change to Powder. After R4, cut Pastel Pink pink yarn and stuff ends into the hand.

R4-11: 6dc

R12-13: Change to Sand, 6dc R14: Change to Cream, 6dc

R15-16: Change to Sand, 6dc

Fold flat. 3dc to close the opening. Cut yarns and weave in ends. We will join the arms to the body later by

crocheting.

Legs (make 2)

Don't stuff legs.

First Leg.

R1: In Sand, work 6dc in a magic ring (6) R2: [2dc in next st, 2dc] twice (8)

R3-5: 8dc

Change to Powder. Cut Sand yarn after round 6 and stuff yarn ends inside the leg.

R6-21: 8dc

R22-24: Change to Grey, 8dc

Fasten off. Cut and weave in end.

Second Leg

Repeat R1-24 of the first leg. R25: 4dc. Leave the rest unworked.

Body

R1: Chain 2, join the first leg with a dc. mark this as the first st of the 1st round of body, 7dc around the rest of the 1st leg, 2dc in one side of chain, 8dc around the 2nd leg, 2dc in the other side of chain. (20)

R2-3: 20dc

Cut Grey yarn

R4: Change to Cream, dc, 19ss in BLO

(20)

R5: 20dc in BLO

R6-10: 20dc

R11: Change to Sand, 20dc

R12: Change to Cream, 20dc

R13: Change to Sand, 20dc. Cut Cream.

R14: 3dc, inv dec, 9dc, inv dec, 4dc (18). Stuff the body as you go from here.

Start joining the arms. Use two stitch

markers, attach the arms to body at the

5th st & 15th st

R15: 4dc, join arm 1 - 3dc in both round 16 of arm 1 and this rnd of body, 7dc,

join arm 2 - 3dc in both round 16 of arm

2 and this rnd of body, 2dc (18)

R16: Change to Powder, [dc, inv dec] 6

times (12)

Cut Sand colour. Start making the head.

Head

Use a dark thread/lace yarn to mark the beginning of each round.

R17: In Powder [dc, inv dec] 4 times) (8)

R18: 2dc in next 8 sts in FLO (16)

R19: [dc, 2dc in next st] 8 times (24)

R20: [3dc, 2dc in next st] 6 times (30)



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R21: [5dc, 2dc in next st] 5 times (35)

R22-29: 35dc

R30: [5dc, inv dec] 5 times (30)

R31: [3dc, inv dec] 6 times (24)

R32: [2dc, inv dec] 6 times (18)

R33: [dc, inv dec] 6 times (12)

R34: [inv dec] 6 times(6)

Fasten off. Cut yarn and leave a tail.

Weave yarn end through the front

loops and pull it tight to close.
