



Lollipop

Materials

Knitcraft Tiny Friends in White, Red and Beige ½ x pipe cleaner

Cardboard circle approximately 5cm diameter

3.5mm crochet hook

Size

Approximately 5.5cm wide x 10cm tall

Pattern Notes

To form the spiral, one half of each round is worked in White and one half in Red. On each round, White is worked in Red sts of previous round and Red is worked in White sts. When changing between colours, remove hook, drop yarn and either extend loop or mark the loop with a stitch marker to prevent unravelling. Do not cut yarn between changes.

Lollipop

(Make 2)

Using White and 3.5mm hook, make 2ch.

Round 1 (RS): In second ch from hook work; 2dc, 3htr, place White stitch on a holder, join Red with sl st in same ch, 2dc, 3htr, place Red stitch on a holder (10 sts).

Round 2: Pick up White, work (2htr in next st) five times, place White stitch on a holder, pick up Red, (2htr in next st) five times, place Red stitch on a holder (20 sts).

Round 3: Pick up White, (1htr, 2htr in next st) five times, place White stitch on a holder, pick up Red, (1htr, 2htr in next st) five times, place Red stitch on a holder (30 sts).

Round 4: Pick up White, 1htr, 14dc, place White stitch on a holder, pick up Red, 1htr, 14dc.

Fasten off.

Lollipop Stick

Using Beige and 3.5mm hook, make 2ch.

Round 1: 6dc in second ch from hook (6 sts).

Rounds 2 to 10: 1dc in each st around.

Fasten off.

Making Up

Cut a circle of cardboard the same size as lollipop, approximately 5cm diameter. Place front and back of lollipop WS together with cardboard sandwiched between, using White and 3.5mm hook, sl st blo around to join pieces together. Cut a length of pipe cleaner a few cm longer than lollipop stick. Push pipe cleaner inside lollipop stick and remainder of pipe cleaner into bottom of lollipop. Sew stick to lollipop.
