



Village Sign

Materials

Knitcraft Tiny Friends in Beige, White, Lime and Hot Pink

Cardboard approximately 3.5cm x 5cm

½ x pipe cleaner

3.5mm crochet hook

Size

Approximately 6.5cm wide x 5cm tall



Sign Front

Using Beige and 3.5mm hook, make 13ch.

Row 1 (RS): 1dc in second ch from hook, 1dc in each st along, turn (12 sts). Cut Beige.

Rows 2 to 7: Join White, 1ch, 1dc in each st along, turn. Cut White at end of row 7.

Row 8: Join Beige, 1ch, 1dc in each st along, turn.

Row 9: 1ch, 3dc, 1htr, 1tr, (2tr in next st) twice, 1tr, 1htr, 3dc (14 sts).

Fasten off.

Sign Back

Using Beige and 3.5mm hook, make 13ch.

Rounds 1 to 9: Rep rounds 1 to 9 of sign front, using Beige throughout.

Fasten off.

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Stand

Using White, make 2ch.

Working 2 rounds in White and 2 rounds in Lime throughout.

Round 1: 6dc in second ch from hook (6 sts).

Rounds 2 to 8: 1dc in each st around.

Fasten off.

Making Up

Split a length of Hot Pink into 2 strands and embroider your village name or message onto the front. Cut a piece of cardboard approximately 3.5cm x 5cm. Place front and back of sign WS together with cardboard sandwiched between, using Beige and 3.5mm hook, with front facing, sl st around the edges to join pieces together. Cut a piece of pipe cleaner the same length as stand. Push pipe cleaner inside stand and sew stand to back of sign, two rows down from top.
