Flanked by one of her beloved corgis, the Queen starts her day happily exploring the palace as she completes her morning duties. There are people to greet, calls to make and perhaps she might even find time to teach her pup a trick.

After she's seen to all her business, it's time to party! Queen Elizabeth has her very own party hat, cake and balloon to get everyone in the mood for a celebration – and with 70 years on the throne, there's good reason to make it a memorable occasion.

Party Hat

Round 1: In Cornflower working into magic ring, 6dc. Continue working in a spiral in continuous rounds.

Round 2: 1dc in each st around. [6dc]

Round 3: Change to Blue (1dc, 2dc in next st) 3 times. [9dc]

Round 4: 1dc in each st around. [9dc]

Round 5: Change to Sage (2dc, 2dc in next st) 3 times. [12dc]

Round 6: 1dc in each st around. [12dc]

Round 7: Change to Yellow (3dc, 2dc in next st) 3 times. [15dc]

Round 8: 1dc in each st around. [15dc]

Round 9: Change to Mustard (4dc, 2dc in next st) 3 times. [18dc]

Round 10: 1dc in each st around. [18dc]

Round 11: Change to Fox (5dc, 2dc in next st) 3 times. [21dc]

Round 12: 1dc in each st around. [21dc]

Round 13: Change to Candy Pink (1dc, ch1) 21 times. [21dc, 21ch sp]

Ss into the next st. Fasten off and sew in your ends.

Make a small pompom in Candy Pink and attach to top of Hat

Cake

Round 1: In Cream, working into magic ring, 6dc. Continue working in a spiral in continuous rounds.

Round 2: (2dc in next st) 6 times. [12dc]

Round 3: (1dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [18dc]

Round 4: (2dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [24dc]

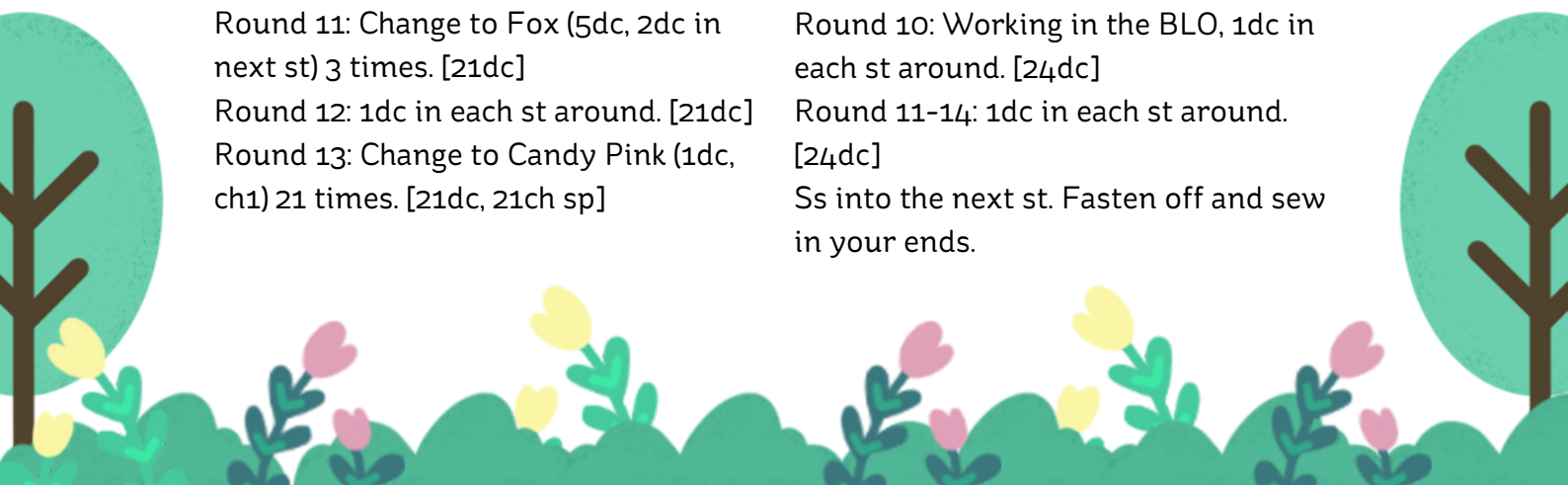
Round 5: Working in the BLO, 1dc in each st around. [24dc]

Round 6-9: 1dc in each st around. [24dc]

Round 10: Working in the BLO, 1dc in each st around. [24dc]

Round 11-14: 1dc in each st around. [24dc]

Ss into the next st. Fasten off and sew in your ends.



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Icing

Join Candy Pink and work 1dc in each FLO of Round 10. Ss into the next st. Fasten off and sew in your ends.

Top Of The Cake

Round 1: In Candy Pink working into magic ring, 6dc. Continue working in a spiral in continuous rounds.

Round 2: (2dc in next st) 6 times. [12dc]

Round 3: (1dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [18dc]

Round 4: (2dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [24dc]

Fasten off Candy Pink and join White.

Round 5: Working in the FLO, (1dc, ch1) in each st around. [24dc, 24x 1ch sp]

Ss into the next st. Fasten off, leaving a long end for attaching to the base of the cake. Sew the top of the cake to the base using round 4 so the icing over hangs and fill with fibre filling as you go.

Candle

Round 1: In Cornflower working into magic ring, 4dc. Continue working in a spiral in continuous rounds.

Round 2: Working in the BLO, 1dc in each st around. [4dc]

Round 3-5: 1dc in each st around. [4dc]
Ss into the next st. Fasten off, leaving a long end for attaching to the top of the cake.

Flame

Row 1: In Mustard working into magic ring, (1dc, 1tr, 1dc). Fasten off Mustard and join Yellow, turn your work and ch1. [3sts]

Row 2: 1dc, (1tr, ch2, 1tr) in the next st, 1dc.

Ss into the next st. Fasten off, leaving a long end for attaching to the candle.

Balloon

Round 1: In Candy Pink working into magic ring, 6dc. Continue working in a spiral in continuous rounds.

Round 2: (2dc in next st) 6 times. [12dc]

Round 3: (1dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [18dc]

Round 4: (2dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [24dc]

Round 5-9: 1dc in each st around. [24dc]
Start to stuff with fibre filling.

Round 10: (6dc, dc2tog) 3 times. [21dc]

Round 11: (5dc, dc2tog) 3 times. [18dc]

Round 12: (4dc, dc2tog) 3 times. [15dc]

Round 13: (3dc, dc2tog) 3 times. [12dc]

Round 14-15: 1dc in each st around. [12dc]

Round 16: (dc2tog) 6 times. [6dc]

Round 17: Ch1, work 1crab stitch in each st around. [6crab st]

Ss into the next st. Fasten off, leaving a long end and wrap around the bottom of the balloon for the tie.

Using 20cm in length of craft wire and Cream yarn, wrap Cream around the wire and glue as you wrap. Secure at the bottom with glue and securely glue inside the opening of the balloon. Bend the wire to desired shape, you can bend around the queen's hand for her to hold it.

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
