Flanked by one of her beloved corgis, the Queen starts her day happily exploring the palace as she completes her morning duties. There are people to greet, calls to make and perhaps she might even find time to teach her pup a trick.

After she's seen to all her business, it's time to party! Queen Elizabeth has her very own party hat, cake and balloon to get everyone in the mood for a celebration – and with 70 years on the throne, there's good reason to make it a memorable occasion.

Crown

Round 1:In Mustard ch25, slst into the 1st ch to make a ring. Work 1dc into each st around. Continue working in a spiral in continuous rounds. [25dc] Round 2: 1dc in each st around [25dc] Round 3: *Slst, dc, (1htr, 3ch ss to 3rd ch from hook, 1htr) in next st, 1dc, repeat from * 5 more times, sl st in last st Fasten off and sew in your ends.

Blue Dress

Starting from the top.

Row 1: In Cornflower ch19, turn and work 1dc in the 2nd ch from hook, 2dc, ch2, 3dc, ch2, 6dc, ch2, 3dc, ch2, 3dc. [18dc, 4x 2ch sp]

Row 2: Ch1, turn and work 3dc, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in 1st ch sp, 3dc, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in next ch sp, 6dc, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in next ch sp, 3dc, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in next ch sp, 3dc. [26dc, 4x 2ch sp]

Row 3: Ch1, turn and work 4dc, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in 1st ch sp, 5dc, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in next ch sp, 8dc, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in next ch sp, 5dc, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in next ch sp, 5dc, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in next ch sp, 4dc. [34dc, 4x 2ch sp]

Row 4: Ch1, turn and work 5dc, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in 1st ch sp, 7dc, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in next ch sp, 10dc, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in next ch sp, 7dc, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in next ch sp, 5dc. [42dc, 4x 2ch sp]

Row 5: Ch1, turn and work 6dc, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in 1st ch sp, 9dc, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in next ch sp, 12dc, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in next ch sp, 9dc, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in next ch sp, 6dc. [50dc, 4x 2ch sp]

Row 6: Ch1, turn and work 7dc, 1dc in 1st ch sp, miss 11dc, 1dc in the next ch sp (this will create your 1st arm hole), 14dc, 1dc in the next ch sp, miss 11dc, 1dc in the next ch sp (this will create your 2nd arm hole), 7dc. [32dc] You will now continue working in a spiral in continuous rounds.



Queen Elizabeth II Day 4

Round 7: Work 1dc in the 1st dc of Row 6, 31dc. [32dc]
Round 8-18: 1dc in each st around.
[32dc]

Round 19: Work (1dc, ch2) 32 times [32dc, 32x 2ch sp] Ss into the next st. Fasten off and sew in your ends.

Sleeves (Repeat for each arm hole)

Join Cornflower to to st at underarm. Round 1-5: Work 1dc in each st around. [11dc]

Ss into the next st. Fasten off and sew in your ends.

Sash

Row 1: In Blue ch51, turn.

Row 2: 1dc into the 2nd ch from hook, 1dc in each st to the end, ch1, turn. [50dc]

Row 3: 1dc in each st to the end. [50dc] Ss into the next st. Fasten off, leaving a long end for sewing.

Tie the sash at the one end and sew in place with the remaining yarn.

Jewellery

Earrings

Sew a pearl to each ear.

Necklace

Thread beads onto a scrap piece of thread and tie around neck
