Narwhal
Colour: Bright Blue

Mc

- R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)
- R2. [1dc, inc] 3 times (9dc)
- R3. 1dc in each st (9dc)
- R4. [2dc, inc] 3 times (12dc)
- R5. 1dc in each st (12dc)
- R6. [3dc, inc] 3 times (15dc)
- R7. 1dc in each st (15dc)
- R8. [4dc, inc] 3 times (18dc)
- R9. 1dc in each st (18dc)
- R10. [2dc, inc] 6 times (24dc)
- R11. [3dc, inc] 6 times (30dc)
- R12. [4dc, inc] 6 times (36dc)
- R13-18. 1dc in each st (36dc)
- R19. [4dc, dec] 6 times (30dc)

Insert safety eyes between R18 and R19, 12sts apart.

R20. [3dc, dec] 6times (24dc)

Start to stuff with fibre filling.

- R21. [2dc, dec] 6 times (18dc)
- R22. [1dc, dec] 6 times (12dc)

R23. [dec] 6 times (6dc)

Fasten off and sew shut.

Tail (make 2)
Colour: Bright Blue

Mc

- R1. 6dc in mc (6dc)
- R2. 1dc in each st (6dc)
- R3. [1dc, inc] 3 times (9dc)
- R4-5. 1dc in each st (9dc)
- R6. [2dc, inc] 3times (12dc)
- R7-8. 1dc in each st (12dc)
- R9. [2dc, dec] 3times (9dc)
- R10. [1dc, dec] 3 times (6dc)
- R11. [dec] 3 times (3dc)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew to the back of the Narwhal.

Flipper (make 2)

Colour: Bright Blue

Mc

R1. 6dc in mc (6dc)

R2. 1dc in each st (6dc)

R3. [1dc, inc] 3 times (9dc)

R4-5. 1dc in each st (9dc)

R6. [1dc, dec] 3 times (6dc)

R7. [dec] 3 times (3dc)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew to each side of the Narwhal.

Cheeks (make 2)

Colour: Hot Pink

Mc

R1. 6dc in the mc (6dc)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew to either side of the face.

With Black, embroider a simple mouth between the eyes.

Horn

Colour: Light Grey

Mc

R1. 4dc in the mc (4dc)

R2-8. 1dc in each st (4dc)

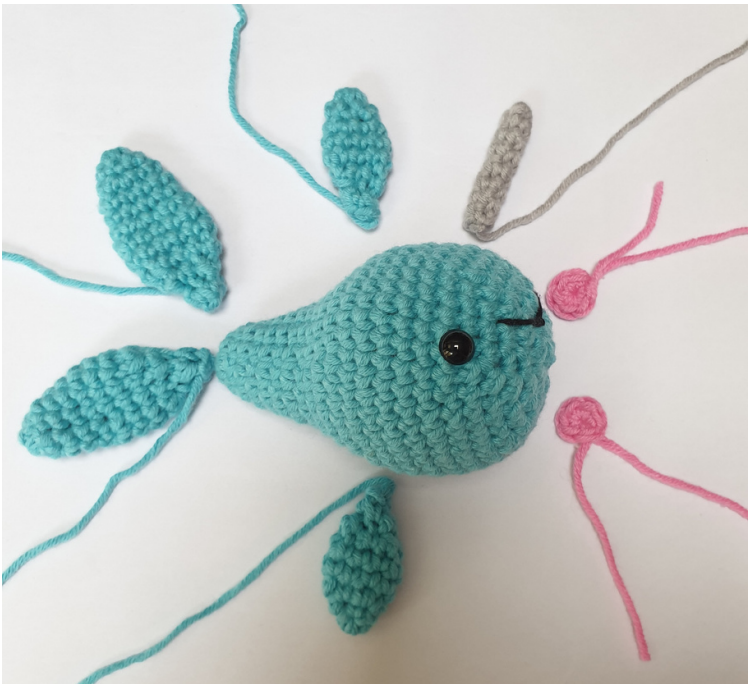
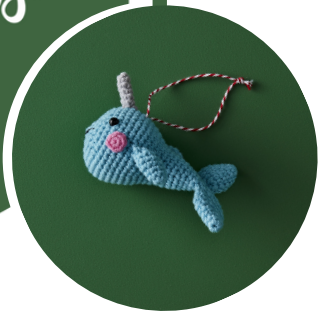


Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew to the front of the Narwhal.

Attach between R20 and R21, between the eyes.

Attach 15cm of Butchers twine to the top of the narwhal, just behind the horn and tie in a knot to secure, this forms the hanging loop.

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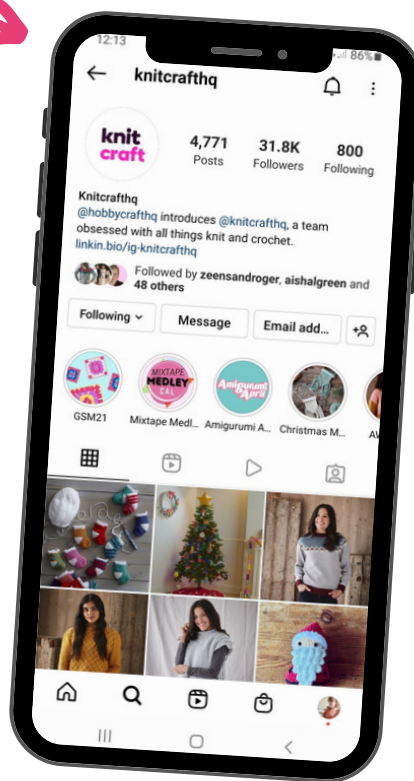
