You will need –

Knitcraft Cotton Blend:

Denim

Light Blue

White

Teal

Coral

Purple

5mm crochet hook

Darning needle

Optional: blocking equipment

Abbreviations

Ch – chain

Dc – double crochet

Htr – half treble crochet

Tr – treble crochet

Dtr – double treble crochet

Mr – magic ring

Ss – slip stitch

Rep – repeat

Rnd 1: With purple, ch1 into mr, then 8dc into the ring. (8 sts)



Rnd 2: 2dc in each stitch around, ss into beginning dc. (16 sts)



Rnd 3: Working into front loops only, *ch10, ss into next stitch, ss into the next stitch*; rep from * to * 6 times more. Finish off with ch10, ss into next stitch. (8 ch10-loops)



Rnd 4: *1dc, 1htr, 8tr, ch2, 8tr, 1htr, 1dc into next ch10-loop*; rep from * to * seven times more, finish off with ss into beginning dc. Fasten off. (160 sts – 8 petals of 20 sts each)



Rnd 5: With denim yarn, working into the back loops of rnd 2, and working with the wrong side facing, ch3, *1htr, 1dc, 1htr, 1tr*; rep from *to * twice more, finishing off with 1htr, 1dc, 1htr, ss into 3rd ch of beginning ch3. (16 sts)



Rnd 6: Still with wrong side facing, ch1 (does not count as a st), now starting in same st, *dc, htr, tr, dtr, ch4*; rep from * to * twice more, to last 4 sts, dc, htr, tr, dtr, close round with dtr into beginning ch (counts as final ch4-sp). Fasten off. (16 stitches, 4 x ch4-sps)



Rnd 7:. With light blue yarn, (ch1, dc) into any dtr, *dc, htr, htr, [2tr, 2dtr] into ch4-sp, ch4, dc*; rep from * to * twice more, dc, htr, htr, [2tr, 2dtr] into ch4-sp, dtr into beginning ch1. FO. (32 sts, 4 x ch4-sps)



Rnd 8: Switch to right side facing. With denim yarn, [ch 1, 3dc, htr] into ch4-sp, *htr, htr, 1tr in next 3 sts, 1dtr in the next 3 sts, ch 4, [3dc, htr] into ch4-sp*; rep from * to * twice more. Finish with htr, htr, 1tr in next 3 sts, 1dtr in the next 3 sts, dtr into beginning ch1. FO. (48 sts, 4 x ch4-sps)



Rnd 9: With light blue yarn, [ch 1, 4dc] into any ch4-sp, *1htr in the next 4 sts, 1tr in the next 4 st, 1dtr in the next 4 sts, ch4, [4dc] into ch4-sp *; rep from * to * twice more. 1htr in the next 4 sts, 1tr in the next 4 sts, 1dtr in the next 4 sts, dtr into beginning ch 1. FO. (64 sts, 4 x ch4-sps)



Rnd 10: With denim yarn, [ch 1, 4dc] into ch4-sp, *1htr in next 6 sts, 1tr in next 5 sts, 1dtr in the next 5 sts, ch4, [4dc] into ch4-sp*; rep from * to * twice more. Finish with 1htr in the next 6 sts, 1tr in next 5 sts, 1dtr in the next 5 sts, dtr into beginning ch space. (80 sts, 4 x ch4-sps)



Rnd 11: Working only on one side of the square, in back loops only and ~~still~~ with light blue yarn. (ch2 (does not count as st), 4htr) in ch4-sp, dc, ss into the next 5 sts, htr into the next 5 sts, ss into the next 5 sts, htr into the next 4 sts, htr into ch4-sp. Ch2 (does not count as st) and turn. (25 sts)



Rnd 12: Working into back loops only. *htr into next 5 stitches, ss into next 5 sts*; rep from * once. Finish off with htr into the next 5 sts. Pull up denim yarn in the last htr. Turn. (25 stitches total)

Rnd 13: Working into back loops only, with denim yarn. Ch1, ss in the same stitch *ss in the next 4 sts, htr into the next 5 sts, ss*; repeat from * once. Finish off with ss into the last 4 sts. Ch1 and turn. (25 sts total)

Rnd 14: Working into back loops only. *ss into next 5 sts, htr into next 5 sts*; rep from * to * once. Finish off with ss into the next 5 sts. Pull up light blue yarn in the last ss. Turn. (25 sts)

Rnd 15: Working into back loops only. Ch1, htr in the same stitch, *htr into next 4 sts, ss into next 5 sts*; rep from * to * once. Finish off with htr into the next 5 sts. (25 sts)

Rnd 16: Working into back loops only. *htr into next 5 stitches, ss into next 5 sts*; rep from * once. Finish off with htr into the next 5 sts. Pull up denim yarn in the last htr. Turn. (25 sts)

Rnd 17: Working into the back loops only. Ch1, ss in the same stitch *ss in the next 4 sts, htr into the next 5 sts, ss*; repeat from * once. Finish off with ss into the last 4 sts, Ch1 and turn. (25 sts)



Rnd 18: Rotate the square 90°, working only on this side. With the denim yarn still attached from the previous row, ch 1, work 5 dc evenly along the side of rnds 11-16, 4tr into ch4-sp, tr into the next st, *dc in the next 5 sts, tr in the next 5 sts*; rep from * to * once more, working last tr of last rep into the base of ch4 from rnd 10). Ch3 (does not count as st) and turn. (30 sts)



Rnd 19: *tr in the next 5 sts, dc in the next 5 sts*; rep from * to * twice more. Pull up light blue yarn on the last dc. (30 sts)

Rnd 20: With light blue yarn, ch 3 (does not count as a st), tr in the same stitch, *tr in the next 4 sts, dc in the next 5 sts, tr*; rep from * to * once more. Finish off with tr in the next 5 sts, dc in the next 5 sts, ch1 and turn. (30 sts)

Rnd 21: *dc in the next 5 sts, tr in the next 5 sts*; rep from * to * twice more. Pull up denim yarn on the last dc, turn. (30 sts)

Rnd 22: With denim yarn, ch 1, dc in the same stitch, *dc in the next 4 sts, tr in the next 5 sts, dc*; rep from * to * once more. Finish off with dc in the next 5 sts, tr in the next 5 sts. (30 sts)



Rnd 23: Continuing on from where you ended on row 20, ch2 (counts as the corner space),*rotate the square 90°, work 30 htr evenly along the side, ch2*; rep from * to * twice more. Ss into beginning dc from rnd 20. Fasten off. (30 sts on each side, 4 corner ch spaces)



Rnd 24: With white yarn, dc into each st, [dc, ch 2, dc] into corner spaces. Fasten off. (32 sts on each side, 4 corner ch spaces)

To make the lilypad (using two strands of teal held together):

Rnd 1: ch1 into a mr, dc6 into magic ring, ss into first dc. (6 sts total)

Rnd 2: ch1, 2dc in each stitch around, ss in first dc. Ch1 and turn. (12 sts total)

Rnd 3: Working on the wrong side facing, [dc in next st, 2dc in next st] around, ss in first dc. Ch1 and turn (18 sts total)

Rnd 4: [dc, dc, 2dc in next st] around. Fasten off. (24 sts total)



For the water lily embellishments:

Using coral yarn.

Starting in the centre of the mr, attach the yarn through a needle and pull through to right side facing, hold the thread taut and wrap it twice around the needle, then pull it gently to tighten the loops. Maintaining the tension, insert the needle into one of the 8 dc from rnd 1, pushing it down through the two loops to form a knot. Pull the yarn back up through the centre and repeat this for all 8 dc holes.



For water 'sparkle':

With white yarn and needle.

Start at A and insert in at B, pull back through at C and insert at D. Come out at E and finish at F.
