You will need:

Knitcraft Cotton Blend in;

- Hot Pink (Yarn A)
- Purple (Yarn B)
- Denim (Yarn C)
- Teal (Yarn D)
- Mustard (Yarn E)
- Coral (Yarn F)
- Red (Yarn G)
- 5mm crochet hook
- Darning Needle
- Scissors

Pattern terminology - Written in UK terms

St/Sts - Stitch/Stitches

SI

Sl st - Slip Stitch

Ch - Chain

BLO - Back loops only

Dc - Double crochet



Special Stitches

Rdtr – Raised double treble; Yarn around hook twice, insert hook into front loop as described in pattern (in this pattern it is always the front loop three rows below), yarn around hook and pull through the stitch, you will have 4 loops on your hook. Yarn around hook and pull through the first two loops, you will have 3 loops left on your hook. Yarn around hook and pull through the next two loops, you will have two loops left on your hook. Yarn around hook and pull through the final two loops. Skip 1 dc (this is the stitch you would have worked into if you had not of worked into the front loop below).

Pattern Notes

This pattern is worked almost entirely in double crochet worked in Back loops only (BLO). For the purposes of this pattern all double crochet stitches should be worked into BLO unless told otherwise. This is especially important as all of the Rdtr sts will be worked into the front loops that are left on the surface of the work.

Do not turn at the end of each round.

Turning chains count towards the stitch count throughout but ch sts do not.



Pattern



In Yarn A, make magic circle.



Rnd 1: 2 ch, 2 dc, *2 ch, 3 dc, repeat from * 2 more times, 2 ch, sl st to top of ch 2. (12 sts)



Rnd 2: 2 ch, 3 dc, *2 ch, 5 dc, repeat from * 2 more times, 2 ch, 1 dc, sl st to top of ch 2. (20 sts)





Rnd 3: Join yarn B. 2 ch, 4 dc, *2 ch, 7 dc, repeat from * 2 more times, 2 ch, 2 dc, sl st to top of ch 2. (28 sts)

Rnd 4: 2 ch, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below (SEE MIDDLE PHOTO BELOW), 4 dc, *2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, repeat from * 2 more times, 2 ch, 3 dc, sl st to top of ch 2. (36 sts)







Rnd 5: Join yarn C, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 1 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, *2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 1 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, repeat from * 2 more times, 2 ch, 4 dc, sl st to top of Rdtr. (44 sts)









Rnd 6: 2 ch, 2 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, *2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 3 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, repeat from * 2 more times, 2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, sl st to top of ch 2. (52 sts)



Rnd 7: Join yarn D, 2 ch, 3 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, *2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 5 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, repeat from * 2 more times, 2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 1 dc, sl st to top of ch 2. (60 sts)



Rnd 8: 2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, *2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 7 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, repeat from * 2 more times, 2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 2 dc, sl st to top of ch 2. (68 sts)





Rnd 9: Join yarn E, 2 ch, 5 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, *2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 9 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, repeat from * 2 more times, 2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 3 dc, sl st to top of ch 2. (76 sts)



Rnd 10: 2 ch, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, *2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 11 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, repeat from * 2 more times, 2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, sl st to top of ch 2. (84 sts)



Rnd 11: Join yarn F, 2 ch, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, *2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, repeat from * 2 more times, 2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 5 dc, sl st to top of ch 2. (92 sts)





Rnd 12: 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 1 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, *2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 1 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, repeat from *2 more times, 2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, sl st to top of Rdtr. (100 sts)



Rnd 13: Join yarn G, 2 ch, 2 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, *2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 3 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, repeat from * 2 more times, 2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 8 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 8 st to top of 2 ch. (108 sts)





Rnd 14: 2 ch, 3 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, *2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 5 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 4 dc, repeat from * 2 more times, 2 ch, 4 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 6 dc, 1 Rdtr in front loop of dc 3 rows below, 1 dc, sl st to top of 2 ch. (116 sts)



Rnd 15: In this round you no longer need to dc in the BLO. Dc as normal. Join yarn A, ch 2, 16 dc, *2 ch, 31 dc, * 2 more times, 2 ch, 14 dc, sl st to top of 2 ch. Fasten off and weave in ends. (124 sts
