You will need:

5 mm Hook

The colour order for this square is Red, Coral, Hot Pink, Yellow, Mustard, Purple, Lilac, Bright Blue, Teal, and Light Blue with a boarder of Denim.

The finished square measures 20 cms.

Corner to corner crochet often called C2C crochet. The square is worked up from corner to corner from Red to Light Blue.



Abbreviations


Ch Chain

DC Double Crochet

TR Treble Crochet



Begin with a slipknot







Ch 6.

TR into the 4th ch from the hook and next 2 ch (4). (I have shown with the green pin the 4th chain).




That is the first of the blocks completed.



Turn your work and ch 6.

TR into the 4th ch from the hook and next 2 ch (4). I have shown with the green pin where the TR goes.





SS into the top right of the previous block.

Ch 3, 3 Tr



Change colour - Coral. Turn your work.



Ch 6, TR into the 4th ch from the hook and next 2 ch (4).



SS into the top right of the previous block.

Ch 3, 3 TR

Repeat pattern of increase (two rows of Hot Pink, Yellow, Mustard)

Turn your work

Ch 6

1 TR into the 4th ch from the hook and next 2 ch (4).

SS into the top right of the previous block.

Ch 3, 3 TR

SS into the top right of the previous block – continue to end of row.

(Increase until the there are two mustard stripes)



Join the Purple. As in the picture this is where you begin to decrease and you join to the top of the previous TR.



Ch 3, 3 TR

SS into the top right of the previous block. Repeat to the end of the row; Ch 3, 3 TR

SS into the top right of the previous block.

At the end of the row turn your work and Ch 3.



Continue to decrease (Lilac, Bright Blue, Teal, Light Blue).



The square is complete ready for the border.





Sew in the ends.



The border is two rounds of Dc.

To begin add the Denim. I have joined the new yarn in the top of the square.

Round one; Ch 2. DC in each TR space, the picture above would be DC in the middle Lilac block, DC in the next two TR then between the Lilac and Purple block, two DC into the sideways TR and DC in between the two blocks. Repeat this around the square. In the corners 2 DC, CH 2, 2DC.

Round two; Ch2, 1dc into each st and (2dc, 2ch, 2dc) into each corner. Repeat this around the square, ss to first dc.

The square is complete, sew in the final ends.
