I started to learn to crochet about 6 years ago. Initially, it wasn't an easy process for me and it took me quite a long time to master how to crochet a chain!

Eventually, something clicked and it all fell into place. I started off making small things for my three daughters and then went on to create my own patterns and Cute Crochet Makes emerged.

I really enjoy designing and creating crochet items, especially blankets. I am probably more well known for creating granny squares with appliques, but I enjoy crocheting pretty much anything.

Things you will need:

Yarn

Knitcraft Cotton Blend Plain in DK,
in colours:

- Denim
- Yellow
- White
- Light Blue

Yarn Details

50% cotton, 50% Acrylic

Hook

5mm

Gauge

16 stitches x 9 rows
(Rows of TR)

Square measures

20cm x 20cm

This pattern is written in UK terms

Dc - Double Crochet

TR - Treble Crochet

HTR - Half Treble Crochet

XTR - Crossed Treble Crochet

SLST - Slip Stitch

ST - Stitch

CH - Chain

MR - Magic Ring

() - brackets indicate stitches to be made in one stitch



1:

Using WHITE in a MR (CH3 – counts as first TR throughout pattern, 2TR) Then in ring (CH1, 3TR) 3 times. CH1 and SLST in 3rd CH of the beginning CH3 to join. Fasten off yarn. **(12 stitches).**

2:

Join YELLOW in any CH1 space. (CH3, 2TR, CH1, 3TR). Make (3TR, CH1, 3TR) in each of the following CH1 corner spaces. SLST in the 3rd CH of the beginning CH3 to join. Fasten off yarn.

(24 stitches)



3:

Join DENIM in any CH1 space. 1DC. * (3TR, CH1, 3TR) in between the next set of 3TR groups. 1DC in the next CH1 space. Repeat from * twice. (3TR, CH1, 3TR) between the next set of 3TR groups. Finish with a SLST in the first DC made. Fasten off yarn.
(28 stitches).



4:

Join WHITE in the CH1 space between the 3TR clusters. 1DC, CH1. * (3TR, CH2, 3TR) around the DC from the previous row. CH1, 1DC in the next CH1 space, CH1. Repeat from * twice. (3TR, CH2, 3TR) around the next DC, CH1 and SLST in the first DC made to join. Fasten off yarn.
(28 stitches).



5:

Join YELLOW in the DC from the round 4. (CH3, 2TR), CH2. * (3TR, CH2, 3TR) in the corner space. CH2 and (3TR) in the next DC from round 4, CH2. Repeat from * twice. (3TR, CH2, 3TR) in the last corner space, CH2 and SLST in the 3rd CH of the beginning CH3 to join. Fasten off yarn.

(36 stitches).



6:

Join DENIM in any CH2 corner space. (CH3, 2TR, CH2, 3TR). *CH2, (3TR) in the 2nd TR of the (3TR) WHITE group from round 4. CH2, (3TR) in the 2nd TR of the next (3TR) WHITE group. CH2 and make (3TR, CH2, 3TR) in the CH2 corner space.

Repeat from * around omitting the final corner and SLST in the 3rd CH of the beginning CH3. Fasten off yarn.

(48 stitches)



7:

Join WHITE in any corner CH2 space. 1DC. * CH2 and make (3TR) in the 2nd TR of the (3TR) LEMON group from round 5. CH2. (3TR, CH1, 3TR) in the 2nd TR of the next LEMON (3TR). CH2, (3TR) in the 2nd TR of the next LEMON (3TR). CH2 and 1DC in the corner space. Repeat from * around omitting the final DC and SLST in the first DC made to join. Fasten off yarn.
(52 stitches).



8:

Join YELLOW in the first CH2 space after the corner. (CH3, 2TR), CH1 and make * (3TR) in the 2nd TR of the (3TR) DENIM group from round 6. CH2 and 1DC in the next CH1 space. CH2, (3TR) in the 2nd TR of the next DENIM group. CH1, (3TR) in the next CH2 space. CH2, (3TR) in the next CH2 space, CH1. Repeat from * around omitting the final (3TR) and make a SLST in the 3rd CH of the beginning CH3 to join. Fasten off yarn. (52 stitches).



9:

Join DENIM in any ST. Make 1DC in each ST and around EACH CH space with (2DC, CH2, 2DC) in each corner space. SLST in the first DC made to join. (Each side has 23DC with CH2 in each corner).



10:

CH2 – counts as first HTR. Make 1HTR in the BACK LOOPS of each ST around with (2HTR, CH2, 2HTR) in each corner space. SLST in the 2nd CH of the beginning CH2 to join. Fasten off yarn. (Each side has 27HTR with CH2 in each corner).

**11:**

Join YELLOW in any corner space. (CH3, 1TR, CH2, 2TR). ** Working in the BACK LOOPS skip the first 2 stitches. 1TR in the 3rd ST. 1TR in the 2nd skipped ST. (XTR made). * Skip a ST and 1TR in the next ST. Make a TR in the skipped ST. Repeat from * across making (2TR, CH2, 2TR) in the corner space. Repeat from ** around finishing with a SLST in the 3rd ST of the beginning CH3. Fasten off yarn. (Each side has 30TR with CH2 in each corner).



12:

Join DENIM in any ST. Make 1DC in the BACK LOOPS in each ST around with (2DC, CH2, 2DC) in each corner space. SLST in the first DC made to join. Fasten off yarn. (Each side has 34DC with CH2 in each corner)



13:

Join LIGHT BLUE in any ST. Make 1DC in each ST around with (2DC, CH1, 2DC) in each corner space. SLST in the first DC made to join. Fasten off yarn and block square. (Each side has 38DC with CH2 in each corner)
