Yarn:

Knitcraft Cotton Blend in:

Yarn A = White

Yarn B = Denim

Yarn C = Bright Blue

Yarn D = Teal

Yarn E = Yellow

Yarn F = Hot Pink

Yarn G = Red

Hook:

5 mm

Abbreviations (UK terms):

ch = chain

htr = half treble crochet

tr = treble crochet

sl st = slip stitch

ch1-sp = chain one space

ch2-sp = chain two space

ch3-sp = chain three space

sk st = skip next stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)

2htr-CL = two half treble cluster group

Round 1: With Yarn A make a magic circle, ch3 (counts as first tr), 2tr into circle, ch3, *3tr into circle, ch3**, repeat from * to ** 2 more times, sl st into top of starting ch3 to join.



Round 2: Continuing with yarn A, ch2 (counts as 1htr), 1htr in next 2 sts, (2htr, ch3, 2htr) into ch3-sp, *1htr in next 3 sts, (2htr, ch3, 2htr) into ch3-sp**, repeat from * to ** 2 more times, sl st into top of starting ch2 to join. Fasten off yarn A



Round 3: Join Yarn B on to 2nd htr along side of the square. Ch2 (counts as 1dc and 1 ch), sk st, *[1dc, ch1, sk st] until end of side, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) into ch3-sp, ch1, sk st**, repeat * to ** 3 more times, sl st into first ch of starting ch2 to join. Fasten off yarn B.



Round 4: Join Yarn C on to first ch1-sp along side of the square. Ch2 (counts as 1dc and 1 ch), *[1dc in next ch1-sp, ch1] until end of side, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) into ch3-sp, ch1**, repeat * to ** 3 more times, sl st into first ch of starting ch2 to join. Fasten off yarn C.



Round 5: Join Yarn D on to first ch1-sp along side of the square. Ch2 (counts as 1dc and 1 ch), *[1dc in next ch1-sp, ch1] until end of side, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) into ch3-sp, ch1**, repeat * to ** 3 more times, sl st into first ch of starting ch2 to join. Fasten off yarn D.



Round 6: Join Yarn E on to first ch1-sp along side of the square. Ch2 (counts as 1dc and 1 ch), *[1dc in next ch1-sp, ch1] until end of side, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) into ch3-sp, ch1**, repeat * to ** 3 more times, sl st into first ch of starting ch2 to join. Fasten off yarn E.



Round 7: Join Yarn F on to first ch1-sp along side of the square. Ch2 (counts as 1dc and 1 ch), *[1dc in next ch1-sp, ch1] until end of side, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) into ch3-sp, ch1**, repeat * to ** 3 more times, sl st into first ch of starting ch2 to join. Fasten off yarn F.



Round 8: Join Yarn G on to first ch1-sp along side of the square. Ch2 (counts as 1dc and 1 ch), *[1dc in next ch1-sp, ch1] until end of side, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) into ch3-sp, ch1**, repeat * to ** 3 more times, sl st into first ch of starting ch2 to join. Fasten off yarn G.



Round 9: Join Yarn A on to first ch1-sp along side of the square. Ch2 (counts as 1htr), 1htr in same ch1-sp, *[2htr in next ch1-sp] until end of side, (2htr, ch2, 2htr) in ch3-sp**, repeat * to ** 3 more times, sl st into top of starting ch2 to join. Do not fasten off yarn.



Note: the 2htrs form clusters which you will crochet in-between in the next round. They are referred to as 2htr-CL

Round 10: Continuing with yarn A, ch2 (counts as 1htr – you will crochet the 2nd 1htr for this 2htr-CL space at the end of the round), *[2htr in each space between 2htr-CL] until end of side, (2htr, ch2, 2htr) in ch2-sp**, repeat * to ** 3 more times, 1htr in first 2htr-CL space to complete first 2htr-CL started at the beginning of the round, then sl st into top of starting ch2 to join. Fasten off yarn A.



Round 11: Join Yarn B on to 2nd htr along side of the square. Ch2 (counts as 1dc and 1 ch), sk st, *[1dc, ch1, sk st] until last stitch of side, 1dc in last st, ch1, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) into ch2-sp, ch1, sk st**, repeat * to ** 3 more times, sl st into first ch of starting ch2 to join. Fasten off yarn B.



Round 12: Join Yarn C on to first ch1-sp along side of the square. Ch2 (counts as 1dc and 1 ch), *[1dc in next ch1-sp, ch1] until end of side, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) into ch3-sp, ch1**, repeat * to ** 3 more times, sl st into first ch of starting ch2 to join. Fasten off yarn C.



Round 13: Join Yarn D on to first ch1-sp along side of the square. Ch2 (counts as 1dc and 1 ch), *[1dc in next ch1-sp, ch1] until end of side, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) into ch3-sp, ch1**, repeat * to ** 3 more times, sl st into first ch of starting ch2 to join. Fasten off yarn D.



Round 14: Join Yarn E on to first ch1-sp along side of the square. Ch2 (counts as 1dc and 1 ch), *[1dc in next ch1-sp, ch1] until end of side, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) into ch3-sp, ch1**, repeat * to ** 3 more times, sl st into first ch of starting ch2 to join. Fasten off yarn E.



Round 15: Join Yarn F on to first ch1-sp along side of the square. Ch2 (counts as 1dc and 1 ch), *[1dc in next ch1-sp, ch1] until end of side, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) into ch3-sp, ch1**, repeat * to ** 3 more times, sl st into first ch of starting ch2 to join. Fasten off yarn F.



Round 16: Join Yarn G on to first dc along side of the square (after a ch3 of a corner) . Ch1 (counts as 1dc), *[1dc in each ch1-sp and dc sts] until end of side, 3dc into ch3-sp**, repeat * to ** 3 more times, sl st into starting ch1 to join. Fasten off yarn G and sew in all ends.
