Written in UK terms

Mc – Magic circle Ch – Chain Tr – Treble crochet Ss – Slip stich Bptr – Back post treble crochet St(s) – Stitch(es) Dc – Double crochet Fo – Fasten off

What you will need:

- Knitcraft cotton blend in hot pink, purple, denim blue, teal, yellow, mustard, coral, red and grey
- 5mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors

Pattern notes:

Do not turn your work after each row. If your square is coming out bigger or smaller, then I recommend using a size smaller or bigger crochet hook. If you crochet tightly, try and do the back post crochet stitches with a looser tension. The finished square will need blocking to straighten the squares sides.



Rnd 1:

Using hot pink and a 5mm hook, Mc, ch3 (counts as a tr here and throughout), 2tr in centre circle, *ch3, 3tr into circle; repeat from * twice more, ch3, join with ss into the top of the ch3 st. Pull tail to close circle tight and Fo. (12tr, 4 ch3)



Rnd 2:

Attach purple to one of the corner spaces, ch3, tr into the corner, 3bptr, *[2tr, 3ch, 2tr] into the corner, 3bptr; repeat from * twice more, 2tr into the corner, ch3, ss into the top of the ch3 st and Fo. (16tr, 12bptr, 4 ch3)



Rnd 3:

Attach denim blue to one of the corner spaces, ch3, tr into the corner, 7bptr, *[2tr, 3ch, 2tr] into the corner, 7bptr; repeat from * twice more, 2tr into the corner, ch3, ss into the top of the ch3 st and Fo. (16tr, 28 bptr, 4 ch3)





Rnd 4:

Attach teal to one of the corner spaces, ch3, tr into the corner, 11bptr, *[2tr, 3ch, 2tr] into the corner, 11bptr; repeat from * twice more, 2tr into the corner, ch3, ss into the top of ch3 st and Fo. (16tr, 44bptr, 4 ch3)



Rnd 5:

Attach yellow to one of the corner spaces, ch3, tr into the corner, 15bptr, *[2tr, 3ch, 2tr] into the corner, 15bptr; repeat from * twice more, 2tr into the corner, ch3, ss into the top of ch3 st and Fo. (16tr, 60bptr, 4 ch3)

Rnd 6:

Attach mustard to one of the corner spaces, ch3, tr into the corner, 19bptr, *[2tr, 3ch, 2tr] into the corner, 19bptr; repeat from * twice more, 2tr into the corner, ch3, ss into the top of ch3 st and Fo. (16tr, 76bptr, 4 ch3)

Rnd 7:

Attach coral to one of the corner spaces, ch3, tr into the corner, 23bptr, *[2tr, 3ch, 2tr] into the corner, 23bptr; repeat from * twice more, 2tr into the corner, ch3, ss into the top of ch3 st and Fo. (16tr, 92bptr, 4 ch3)

Rnd 8:

Attach red to one of the corner spaces, ch3, tr into the corner, 27bptr, *[2tr, 3ch, 2tr] into the corner, 27bptr; repeat from * twice more, 2tr into the corner, ch3, ss into the top of ch3 st and Fo. (16tr, 108bptr, 4 ch3)

Border

Using grey, attach to any st, ch1 (doesn't count as a st), dc in each st to the next corner space, *[2dc, ch1, 2dc] into corner space, dc in each st to the next corner; repeat from * three more times and finish when you reach the end of the round, join with ss in the top of the first dc. Fo, sew in the ends and block.
